A10. What sitting Supreme Court Justice of the US do you most admire and why?	I do not admire one particular Justice more than the others. However, I appreciate various things about certain Justices currently sitting on the Court. First, I appreciate Justice Sotomayor's background. She came from the Bronx and achieved tremendous success in school, but chose to be a district attorney, which frustrated member of her community. She gained practical experience as a trial judge for many years. I also appreciate Justice Breyer, who has written and spoken about his "purposive" approach to justice. I also have thought about whether I naturally have any judicial philosophy, and how such a philosophy might manifest.
